Dan Green is Deputy Director, Healthcare and Insurance at the U.S. Office of Personnel Management. Healthcare and Insurance (HI) oversees health, life and other insurance programs for Federal employees. The \$40 billion Federal Employees Health Insurance Program is the nation's largest employer-sponsored health insurance program, providing 8 million Federal employees, retirees and their families with a variety of quality healthcare options. It is recognized as an efficient, effective program and served as one of the models on which new state health exchanges were created in the Affordable Care Act of 2010. In addition, HI is charged with fulfilling mandates in the healthcare reform legislation regarding the creation of multi-state health insurance plans that will be offered to all Americans on the state health exchanges.

Mr. Green was previously Deputy Director of Planning and Policy Analysis and, prior to January 2010, Deputy Associate Director of Employee and Family Support Policy where he led a team of benefit and other analysts that developed policy options in the benefits and work/life areas affecting millions of Federal employees. In those roles he developed and promoted Administration proposals, leading to the enactment of a number of pieces of legislation improving retirement benefits, employee insurance, and telework benefits.

Mr. Green is a proud 39-year career Federal employee. He earned a Masters in Business Administration from the George Washington University. He received the prestigious OPM Leadership Excellence Award in 2006.
