- Large Provider Agreements (FEHBAR 1652.204-74). Please note that the Large Provider Agreements will be effective October 1, 2005.
- Contractor Records Retention (FEHBAR 1652.204-70)

We will send amendments to the 2005 contract to include the new regulations. The amended contract clauses are included in Attachment B. We are submitting technical amendments to change the effective dates of the FEHBAR clauses to July 2005.

Please note that all carriers will be required to issue a disclosure notice under P.L. 108-173 of the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003. We have provided language for the disclosure notice in the 2006 plan brochures.
