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## Section 2. How we change for 2005

Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

### Program-wide changes

- In Section 9, we revised the **Medicare Primary Payer Chart** and updated the language regarding Medicare Advantage plans (formerly called Medicare + Choice plans).
- In Section 12, we revised the language regarding the Flexible Spending Account Program - *FSAFEDS* and the Federal Long Term Care Insurance Program.

### Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 6.9% for Self Only or 7.7% for Self and Family.
- Your copay for dialysis will decrease from \$20 when done in the specialist's office to \$10.
- Your copay for external insulin pumps will decrease from 20% of the Plan's allowance to \$0 when received from Plan providers.
- Your copay for mammography, screening sigmoidoscopy, psa testing, and screening colonoscopy will decrease from \$10 if done in the PCP's office and \$20 if done in the specialist's office to \$0
- Your coverage for Durable Medical Equipment will now include colonostomy, ilioostomy, and tracheostomy supplies, and suction and urinary catheters.

- Your mail order pharmacy benefits will be provided through PharmaCare Direct.
- Your mental health benefits will be provided through Sentara Behavioral Health Services.
