## Section 2. How we change for 2006

---

Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

### Changes to this Plan

#### Changes to both High and Standard Options

- You now pay a specialty copayment for visits to obstetricians and gynecologists in Colorado Springs. ([See page 11.](#))
- We changed your copayment for pulmonary rehabilitation to \$5 per visit. ([See page 26.](#))
- We have added an out-of-area student benefit that provides coverage of routine, continuing and follow-up medical care for full-time college students attending an accredited institution outside any Kaiser Permanente service area. You pay 20% coinsurance of the usual and customary charges. This benefit is limited to \$1,200 each calendar year. ([See page 61.](#))

#### Changes to High Option only

- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 26.9% for Self Only or increase by 36.4% for Self and Family.
- You now pay nothing for preventive care visits (adult and children) and maternity care visits. ([See page 21.](#))
- Your dental benefits have changed. You can now use Delta Dental participating dentists or other non-participating dentists. The copayment schedule has been replaced with coinsurance. You pay coinsurance for preventive, diagnostic, basic and major dental services. ([See page 62.](#))

#### Changes to Standard Option only

- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 6.8% for Self Only or increase by 4.6% for Self and Family.
