### **Changes to High Option Only**

- Your share of the non-Postal premium will decrease by 2.6% for Self Only or 1.4% for Self and Family.
- You will now pay a \$20 copayment per visit to your primary care physician.
- You will now pay a \$25 copayment for diagnostic services.
- You will now pay a \$25 copayment for an X-ray.
- You will now pay a \$25 copayment for occupational and physical therapy.
- You will now pay a \$25 copayment for speech therapy.
- You will now pay a \$25 copayment for chiropractic services.
- You will now pay an inpatient hospital copayment of \$125 per day up to \$625 maximum per admission. The copayment is waived if readmitted within 90 days of discharge for same diagnosis.
- You will now pay an \$100 copayment for surgery at an outpatient hospital or ambulatory surgical facility.
- You will now pay a \$50 per visit copayment for the use of the emergency room. The copayment is waived if you are admitted to the hospital.
- You will now pay a \$60 copayment for palliative treatment of dental pain.

### **Changes to Standard Option Coverage**

- We will now offer Standard Option coverage for the first time. If you would like to enroll in our Standard Option coverage, you must make an election during Open Season. The Standard Option enrollment codes are: ED4 and ED5.
