
Section 2. How we change for 2008

Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

Program-wide changes

- Texas and West Virginia were removed from the list for 2008 of medically underserved areas.

Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the premium will **decrease** for Self Only and For Self and Family. See back cover.
- For routine physical exams, the maximum benefits changes from \$500 per calendar year to \$700 per calendar year. See page 20.
- HPV, Adacel, Rotavirus and Shingles Vaccines were added to preventative care for adults and children benefits. See page 21.
- The precertification visit limit for physical and occupational therapy has been eliminated. See page 25.
- The prescription drug structure has been renamed as Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3.
- The Tier 3 network retail pharmacy drug copayment has changed to 30% or \$45 whichever is greater.
- The Tier 3 network mail order pharmacy drug copayment has changed to 30% or \$90 whichever is greater
- Members who purchase specialty pharmacy drugs will pay a 5% coinsurance, up to a maximum of \$150 per drug.
