Changes to this Plan

- United States Postal Service nonlaw enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See page 62.
- Your share of the nonpostal premium for High Option will:
 - Increase for Self only or increase for Self and Family for Southeast Michigan (code LX). See page 62.
 - Increase for Self only or increase for Self and Family for Mid- Michigan (code LN). See page 62.
 - Increase for Self only or increase for Self and Family for East Michigan (code K5). See page 62.
- We eliminated the Standard Option.
- We added coverage for one hearing exam and binaural hearing aid for children under age 19 and one unilateral hearing aid every 36 months for adults age 19 and older; a \$5 office visit copay applies (see page 21).
- We decreased the copay for emergency care at an urgent care facility from \$35 per visit to \$10 per visit (see pages 17, 33, 34).
