Changes to this Plan

Benefit Changes for Plan Code B9 - St. Louis

- United States Postal Service Non-Law Enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See page 70.
- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 70.
- **Primary Care Physician (PCP) visits for children through age 12:** The copayment for primary care physician visits for children through age 12 will decrease to \$0. See page 17.
- **Specialist office visits:** The copayments for specialist visits will increase to \$30. See page 16.
- **Outpatient facility:** The copayment for outpatient surgical facility charge will increase to \$150. See page 32.
- **Inpatient Hospital:** The copayment for inpatient hospital will change to \$150 per day up to 3 days per inpatient hospital admission. See page 31.
- **Prescription drugs (retail):** The copayments for prescription drugs purchased at a retail Plan pharmacy will remain at \$7 - Tier 1, and \$50 - Tier 3. Tier 2 will increase to \$30 See page 40.
- **Prescription drugs (mail order):** The copayments for prescription drugs purchased through Plan mail order for up to a 90 day supply will remain at \$17.50 for Tier 1 and \$125 for Tier 3. Tier 2 will increase to \$75. See page 40.

Benefit Changes for Plan Code GX - Kansas City

- United States Postal Service Non-Law Enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See page 70.
- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 70.
- **Primary Care Physician (PCP) visits for children through age 12:** The copayment for primary care physician visits for children through age 12 will decrease to \$0. See page 17.
- **Outpatient facility charge:** The copayment for outpatient surgical facility charge will increase to \$150. See page 32.

Benefit Changes for Plan Code B9 (St. Louis) and Plan Code GX (Kansas City)

- Members are no longer required to use the specialty pharmacy to fill medications that treat rare, unusual or complex diseases.
