
Section 2. How we change for 2008

Do not rely only on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

Changes to this Plan

- United States Postal Service non-law enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See pages 85-86.

Changes to High Option

- Enrollment Code 9E. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 85.
- Enrollment Code JC. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code P3. Your share of the non-Postal premium will decrease for Self Only and decrease for Self and Family. See page 85.
- Enrollment Code JR. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code SL. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code PU. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Under “Diagnostic and treatment services,” we have decreased the copayment to \$50 per visit for the professional services of physicians in an urgent care center. See page 21.
- Under “Preventive care, children,” there no longer will be a copay for Primary Care Physician (PCP) visits for well-child care for routine examinations, immunizations and care for children through age 17; however, the copay for PCP visits for this care for children ages 18 to 22 will remain at \$20 per visit. See page 24.
- Under “Emergency services/accidents,” the copay will be reduced to \$50 per visit for emergency care received at an urgent care center, whether within or outside the service area. See page 45.
- Under “Prescription drug benefits,” we have increased the copay to \$50 for Non-formulary drugs (Generic or Brand) for up to a 30-day supply per prescription or refill obtained at a Retail Pharmacy, and to \$100 for a 31-day up to a 90-day supply per prescription or refill obtained from the Mail Order Pharmacy. Changes to Basic Option Only

- Enrollment Code 9E. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 85.
- Enrollment Code JC. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and decrease for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code P3. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 85.
- Enrollment Code JR. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and decrease for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code SL. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.
- Enrollment Code PU. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page 86.

- Under “Diagnostic and treatment services,” we have decreased the copayment to \$100 per visit for the professional services of physicians in an urgent care center. See page 21.
- Under “Inpatient hospital benefits,” you now will pay 20% of our Plan allowance per admission. See page 41.
- Under “Outpatient hospital or ambulatory surgical center,” you now will pay 20% of our Plan allowance per visit. See page 42.
- Under “Emergency services/accidents,” the copay will be reduced to \$100 per visit for emergency care received at an urgent care center, whether within or outside the service area. See page 45.

Changes to both High and Basic Options

- “Home health services,” now are subject to a member coinsurance of 20% of our Plan allowance. See page 30.
- We added a portion of the state of Delaware to our existing Service Area of Southern NJ, Philadelphia, and Southeastern PA (Enrollment Code P3): the entire counties of Kent, New Castle, and Sussex. See page 10.
- We added the following to the Dallas/Ft. Worth Service Area in the state of Texas (Enrollment Code PU): the cities of El Paso and Corpus Christi and the entire counties of Aransas, Bee, El Paso, Jim Wells, Kleberg, and San Patricio, and portions of the following counties as defined by the below listed towns:
 - Duval: Benavides, Concepcion, and San Diego
 - Live Oak: George West, Three Rivers, and Dinero
 - Nueces: Agua Dulce, Banquete, Bishop, Chapman Ranch, Driscoll, Port Aransas, and Robstown. See page 10.
