Subject: The Federal Long Term Care Insurance Program – Open Season April 4 – June 24, 2011

Beginning in October 2009 the Federal Long Term Care Insurance Program (FLTCIP) introduced a new plan, FLTCIP 2.0, with enhanced features for current FLTCIP enrollees. Now that all current enrollees are "settled", it's time to move forward with the second phase of the FLTCIP 2.0 rollout.

This Benefits Administration Letter (BAL) serves as notification of an Open Season for FLTCIP. During the Open Season, actively at work employees and their spouses (including same-sex domestic partners of civilian workforce members) who are <u>not</u> currently enrolled will be able to apply to the FLTCIP with abbreviated underwriting. Non-enrolled annuitants and other qualified relatives can apply for coverage with a full underwriting application during this period, as well as at any time during the year.

This Open Season will run from April 4, 2011 through June 24, 2011.
