Subject: The Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS) Increasing

Health Care Account Maximum by \$50 to \$2,550

Purpose

To notify agencies and participants that the Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS) is increasing the maximum contribution to health care and limited expense health care flexible spending accounts for the 2015 benefit year. The new maximum contribution will increase \$50 to \$2,550.

Background

The Affordable Care Act capped the maximum annual contribution to a health care flexible spending account at \$2,500 adjusted for inflation in increments of \$50.

Citing inflation, on October 30, 2014, IRS Revenue Procedure 2014-61 raised this cap to \$2,550 for the 2015 benefit year.

FSAFEDS is adopting this higher maximum for the 2015 benefit year to enhance FSAFEDS benefits.
