<p align="center"><b>Getting Started</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Check to see if your current health plan is leaving the Program next year or if its service area is changing.</li> <li>✓ Check the premium you will pay next year for your current health plan.</li> <li>✓ Review your current health plan’s 2014 brochure to see what changes were made for covered services and supplies. See if your out-of-pocket costs are changing.</li> <li>✓ What is the best type of health plan for you – Fee-for-Service, Health Maintenance Organization, High Deductible Health Plan, or Consumer Driven Health Plan?</li> </ul>
<p align="center"><b>Reviewing Your Options</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ You can quickly compare health plans by looking at Appendix E of the <i>2014 FEHB Guide for Tribal Employees</i>. <p align="center"><b>If You Want to Make a Change</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Submit a Health Benefits Election Form, SF 2809 to your tribal employer.</li> </ul>
<p align="center"><b>If You Do Not Want to Make a Change</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ If you are satisfied with your current FEHB plan and the premium for next year, you do not have to do anything. Your enrollment will automatically continue.</li> </ul>
