Subject: The Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS) Increasing Health Care Account Maximum by \$50 to \$2,650

Purpose

This Benefits Administration Letter is to notify agencies that the Office of Personnel Management is increasing the maximum contribution under the Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS) to Health Care and Limited Expense Health Care Flexible Spending Accounts for the 2018 benefit year. The maximum contribution will increase by \$50 to \$2,650.

Background

In October 2017, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) released Revenue Procedure 2017-58, raising the cap to \$2,650 for the 2018 benefit year. OPM is adopting this higher maximum to create a more attractive FSAFEDS benefit to attract and retain Federal employees.
