Leadership Conference

The Asian American Government Executive Network will hold their first Leadership Conference on October 6, 2005 in Crystal City, Virginia. AAGEN focuses on Federal Executives at the GS14 and military service members at the O-6 level and above. The training conference is targeted to high potential executives, who wish to build upon their careers in Federal service.

The Leadership Conference is a one day training event targeted to Federal civilian and military employees that qualifies as training in compliance with 5 U.S.C. Chapter 41.

The training will cover specific career and leadership topics, such as career management, development of the Executive Core Qualifications, and improving individual skills necessary to advance in Federal service.
