Every year, the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) seeks applications from charitable organizations such as yours to participate in the CFC. Last month, we were pleased to announce the opening of the new CFC Application System and, pursuant to 5 CFR §950.601(a)(1), it was announced that the system would receive applications through January 31, 2017.

The response to system has been tremendous and the Office of CFC continues to offer organizations training on the use of the new system and on newly revised CFC regulations, which came into effect on January 1, 2017. Therefore, in an effort to offer every opportunity to nonprofit organizations seeking to participate in this outstanding program, I am extending the application deadline through February 28, 2017.
