Getting Started	 Check to see if your current health plan is leaving the Program next year or if its service area is changing. Check the premium you will pay next year for your current health plan. Review your current health plan's 2016 brochure to see what changes were made for covered services and supplies. See if your out-of-pocket costs are changing. Determine what is the best type of health plan for you – <u>Fee-for-Service Plan</u>, <u>Health Maintenance Organization Plan</u>, <u>High Deductible Health Plan</u>, or <u>Consumer Driven Health Plan</u>. Determine what enrollment type best meets your needs. Note the new Self Plus One enrollment type that will cover you and one eligible family member.

If You Want to Make a Change	✓ Submit a Health Benefits Election Form, SF 2809 to your tribal employer.
If You Do Not Want to Make a Change	 If you are satisfied with your current FEHB plan and the premium for next year, you do not have to do anything. Your enrollment will automatically continue.
