Subject: 2017 FEHB Open Season for Tribal Employees: Ordering and Distributing Materials

This Tribal Benefits Administration Letter (TBAL) is the second in our series of 2017 Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Open Season for Tribal Employees TBALs. This TBAL (17-702) provides instructions for ordering and distributing FEHB Open Season materials.

1) to provide tribal employees the option of viewing brochures online or to receive a

paper copy of their health plan's brochure; and

2) to limit the number of brochures printed and distributed to tribal employers.
