
Section 2 How we change for 2007

Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the non-Postal premium for enrollment code GX for the High Option will increase by 1.7% for Self Only coverage or 8.1% for Self and Family coverage.
- Copayments for Primary Care Physician office visits will decrease to \$10 per visit. See page 16.
- Copayments for Specialist office visits will increase to \$30 per visit. See page 16.
- Copayments for Outpatient Surgical Facilities will increase to \$50 per visit. See page 34.
- Copayments for childhood immunizations for children from birth to age 5 will decrease from \$20 to \$0. See page 19.
- Copayments for prescription drugs purchased at a retail Plan pharmacy will decrease to \$7 Tier 1, . See page 41.
- Copayments for prescription drugs purchased through Plan mail order will decrease to \$17.50 Tier 1. See page 41.
- Copayments for specialty prescription drugs will be \$7 Tier 1, \$30 Tier 2, and \$50 Tier 3 for a 30-day supply. See page 42.
- Inpatient hospital copayment is changing to \$150 per day up to 3 days per admission. See page 33.
- The number of visits for chiropractic services will increase from 24 to 26 per calendar year. See page 25.
- Service area expansion: Jackson, Jefferson and Osage counties have been added to service area GX. For complete listing of service area for 2007 see page 7.
- We now require that you use the Specialty Pharmacy Program for prescription drugs to treat specific conditions. See page 42.
- We now cover genetic counseling. See page 20.
