
Section 2. How we change for 2008

Do not rely only on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

Changes to this Plan

- United States Postal Service non-law enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See page 58.
- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and for Self and Family. See page 58.
- PersonalCare is now available in Knox, Edgar, McHenry, McLean, and Warren Counties.
- Your office visit copay for a Primary Care Physician increases to \$25 per visit.
- Your office visit copay for a Specialist will be \$35 per visit.
- The inpatient hospital copay increases to \$200 per day up to a maximum of \$1,000 per admission.
- The outpatient hospital copay for surgical procedures will be \$100 per visit.
- The office visit copay for pervasive developmental disorders (PDD) will be \$35 per visit, limited to 20 visits per year.
- The hospital outpatient emergency care copay will be \$175 or 50%, whichever is less.
- The retail prescription drug copay increases to \$10/\$30/\$60 (generic/name brand formulary/name brand non-formulary, respectively).
