
Section 2 How we change for 2006

Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the non-postal premium will increase by 17.8% for Self Only or 17.6% for Self and Family.
- The following counties in Nebraska were added to our Service Area: Boyd, Hold Cedar, and Knox counties. (see page 6)
- The following counties in Minnesota were eliminated from our Service Area: Cottonwood, Jackson, Lincoln, Murray, Nobles, Pipestone, and Rock counties. (see page 6)
- A language change was made to replace “Non-routine Mammograms” with “Mammograms rendered outside of schedule”. (see page 16)
- A language change was made to replace “Colorectal Cancer Screening” with “Colorectal Cancer Testing, including”. (see page 16)
- A language change was made to replace “Routine Osteoporosis Screening” with “Osteoporosis Testing (according to schedule) one baseline test after the age of 50. Note: Osteoporosis testing outside of schedule will be subject to deductible/coinsurance”. (see page 16)
- A language change was made to replace “Routine Mammogram – covered for women age 35 and older, as follows:” with “Mammogram – covered for women age 35 and older, as follows:” (see page 17)
