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## Section 2 How we change for 2007

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Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 *Benefits*. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

### Program-wide changes

- In Section 3, under **Covered providers**, for 2007 Texas was added to the list for medically underserved areas and Alaska was deleted.

### Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the premium will increase by 2.1% for Self Only or 2.4% for Self and Family.
- We have added a benefit for pertussis immunization for members age 22 to 64 (see page 25).
- We have added a benefit for Varicella (chickenpox) immunization for members age 22 and older (see page 25).
- We have added a benefit for retinal screening exam performed by an ophthalmologist for infants with low birth weight, less than 1 year of age and with an unstable clinical course (see page 25).
- We have added a weight management program benefit to our Educational classes and programs benefit (see page 35) and added dietitians and nutritionists to covered providers (see page 10) in support of this benefit.
- We have expanded our list of covered organ/tissue transplants (see page 40).
- We have changed the Organ/tissue transplant benefit to encourage use of the Plan's Medical Specialty Network of Centers of Excellence (see pages 40 and 41).
- We have improved our Emergency services/accidents benefit to provide 100% coverage for ancillary services performed at the time of the emergency room visit or initial office visit (see page 46).
- We have introduced a three-tiered prescription drug coinsurance/copayment consisting of generic, single-source brand name and multi-source brand name (see pages 56 and 57).
- We have clarified the cost of specialty drugs at network retail pharmacies and changed the copay for specialty drugs at mail order from \$40 copay to 25% coinsurance with a \$150 cap per prescription (see page 57).
- We have removed the deductible from the benefit for purchasing prescriptions from a retail pharmacy outside the 50 United States (see page 67).
- We have added a benefit for second opinions for certain diagnoses when performed by eCleveland Clinic for members who reside in and receive treatment in foreign countries (see page 61).
- For 2007, the Foreign Service Benefit Plan will offer paperless reimbursement for members enrolled in FSAFEDS (see page 84).
