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## Section 2 How we change for 2007

### Program-wide changes

- In Section 3, under **Covered providers**, Texas is designated as a medically underserved area in 2007. Alaska is no longer designated as a medically underserved area in 2007.

### Changes to this Plan

- Your share of the Postal premium will increase by 2.1% for Self Only or 2.7 % for Self and Family.
- We now provide coverage for a Varicella (chickenpox) immunization for adults.
- We now provide coverage for a retinal screening examination for children.
- We now provide benefits for the Rotavirus vaccine for children.
- We waive the hospital copayment for a maternity stay at a PPO hospital.
- We have expanded the organ/tissue transplants covered by the Plan.
- Laboratory charges will be paid at 100% when your medical provider uses the Lab Card Program of Lab One/Quest Diagnostics to process the specimen. See **Special features**, Section 5(g) for complete information.
- We changed the Plan's catastrophic protection out-of-pocket maximum for PPO services from \$3,000 per person/\$3,500 per family to \$3,500 per person/\$4,000 per family and for PPO and non-PPO services combined from \$3,500 per person/\$4,000 per family to \$4,000 per person/\$4,500 per family.
