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## Section 2 How we change for 2007

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Do not rely on these change descriptions; this Section is not an official statement of benefits. For that, go to Section 5 Benefits. Also, we edited and clarified language throughout the brochure; any language change not shown here is a clarification that does not change benefits.

### Changes to this Plan

- Members in Colorado (code 9E), Oklahoma (code SL), New York & Connecticut (code JC), Dallas/Ft. Worth, Texas (code PU), Southern New Jersey, Southeast Pennsylvania & Philadelphia (code P3), and Northern New Jersey (code JR) have been transferred from the Aetna Open Access Plan described in brochure RI 73-806, to this new Aetna Open Access Plan. Please review this brochure for your 2007 benefits changes.
- This new Aetna Open Access Plan has a High Option and a Basic Option. Members currently enrolled in this Plan's High Option codes, who wish to remain enrolled in the High Option, do not need to do anything at Open Season. However, if you wish to enroll in this Plan's Basic Option, you must enroll in the Basic Option codes during Open Season.

### Changes to High Option

- Enrollment code 9E. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 75.3% for Self Only and increase by 69.9% for Self and Family.
- Enrollment code SL. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 5.4% for Self Only and increase by 5.5% for Self and Family.
- Enrollment code JC. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 29.8% for Self Only and increase by 25.4% for Self and Family.
- Enrollment code PU. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 57.0% for Self Only and increase by 49.2% for Self and Family.
- Enrollment code P3. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 14.9% for Self Only and increase by 14.0% for Self and Family.
- Enrollment code JR. Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase by 35.8% for Self Only and increase by 37.5% for Self and Family.
- We have increased the "Outpatient Hospital or Ambulatory Surgical Center" copay to \$175 per visit. (See page 43)
- Under "Dental Benefits," the "Oral Surgery" section shows that the charge for "Deep sedation/general anesthesia (in office)" only applies to the first 30 minutes. Any anesthesia after that time requires an additional charge at the discounted rate. (See page 58)
- Under "Dental Benefits," the "Oral Surgery" section shows that the discounted rate for "Extractions (surgical, soft tissue, and bony impacted teeth)" applies per tooth. (See page 58)
- We have expanded our current disease management programs to include 30 chronic conditions at no cost to you. (See page 31)
- We cover Varicella (Chicken pox) vaccine – for all persons age 19 to 49 years. (See page 22)
- We cover Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine – for persons 19 to 64 years of age, with booster every ten years. The Tdap vaccine replaces the tetanus-diphtheria vaccine for those under the age of 64. For 65 and above, we cover a tetanus-diphtheria booster every 10 years. (See page 22)
- We cover Hepatitis A vaccine – for all infants 12 to 23 months of age. (See page 23)
- We cover Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine – for children 11 to 12 years of age or for 13 to 18 years of age for those who did not previously receive the vaccination. (See page 23)
- We cover vaccine to prevent Rotavirus for infants between eight to thirty-two weeks of age. (See page 23)

- We cover Screening examination of premature infants for Retinopathy of Prematurity – A retinal screening exam performed by an ophthalmologist for infants with low birth weight (<1500g) or gestational age of 32 weeks or less and infants weighing between 1500 and 2000g or gestational age of more than 32 weeks with an unstable clinical course. (See page 23)
- We added the following to our Service Area in the State of Colorado: the entire county of Broomfield (Enrollment code 9E). (See page 10)
- We added the following to our Service Area in the State of New York: Upstate New York, which includes the entire counties of Broome, Cayuga, Onondaga, Oswego, and Tioga (Enrollment code JC). (See page 10)
- We added the following to our Service Area in the State of Pennsylvania: Central Pennsylvania, which includes the entire counties of Adams, Carbon, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry, Schuylkill, and York (Enrollment code P3). (See page 10)
