Changes to this High Option Plan

- United States Postal Service non-law enforcement career employees may now be covered either by Postal Category 1 or Postal Category 2 premium rates. See page 62.
- Your share of the non-Postal premium will increase for Self Only and increase for Self and Family. See page xxx.
- **Service area expansion**-We have added the Macon area counties of Monroe, Jones, Bibb, Crawford, Taylor, Macon, Peach, Houston and Twig, Georgia. See page 6.
- **Office visits:** Copayments for primary care physician (PCP) ages 13 and up will decrease to \$10 per visit. See page 16.
- **Office visits:** Copayments for primary care physicians ages 0-12 will decrease to nothing per visit. See page 16.
- **Out-of-pocket maximum:** Your catastrophic protection out-of-pocket maximum will increase to \$2,000 per person or \$4,000 per family enrollment in any calendar year. See page 12.
- **Outpatient surgical facility charge**-Copayments for outpatient surgical facilities will increase to \$150 per visit. See page 30.
- **Prescription drug copayments**-Copayments for Tier 3 will increase to \$45 for Plan retail pharmacies and \$135 for Plan mail order. See page 39.
- **Specialty Pharmacy program**- Members are no longer required to use the Specialty Program to fill prescriptions used to treat certain rare, unusual or complex diseases. You may now elect to use this program voluntarily. See page 37 for information on the advantages of the Specialty Pharmacy Program.
