## **OPM Launches New Electronic Official Personnel Folder Platform**

**Washington, D.C.** – The U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) launched the new Electronic Official Personnel Folder (eOPF) platform and completed the migration of more than 400 million files and over five million user accounts, a significant milestone in OPM's commitment to modernizing federal human resources systems. This cloudbased, state-of-the-art eOPF system replaces the legacy Official Personnel Folder (OPF) system that was decommissioned at the end of May.

"This launch represents a major step forward in OPM's mission to modernize HR systems," **Acting Director Chuck Ezell said**. "The new eOPF platform improves accessibility and usability while also setting a new standard for efficiency and innovation in federal human resources management."

The new platform delivers a modern, intuitive experience. Key enhancements include:

- Files can be viewed directly in the platform without downloading PDFs.
- A cleaner, more intuitive interface for seamless access to personnel records.
- Streamlined options for printing and downloading documents.
