Semester of Service is a government-wide, unpaid student volunteer program designed to:

- Provide valuable public service experience
- Support academic and experiential learning goals
- Introduce students to career pathways in the federal government
- Strengthen professional and technical skills through real-world assignments

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- Currently enrolled not less than half-time in a qualifying educational institution
- In good academic standing
- Pursuing an education in any field of study
- Interested in public service, experiential learning, or capstone-style projects
- Eager to explore careers in the federal government

- Cohort Experience – Join a structured national cohort of up to 200 students.
- Project-Based Work – Contribute to clearly defined assignments that support real federal initiatives.
