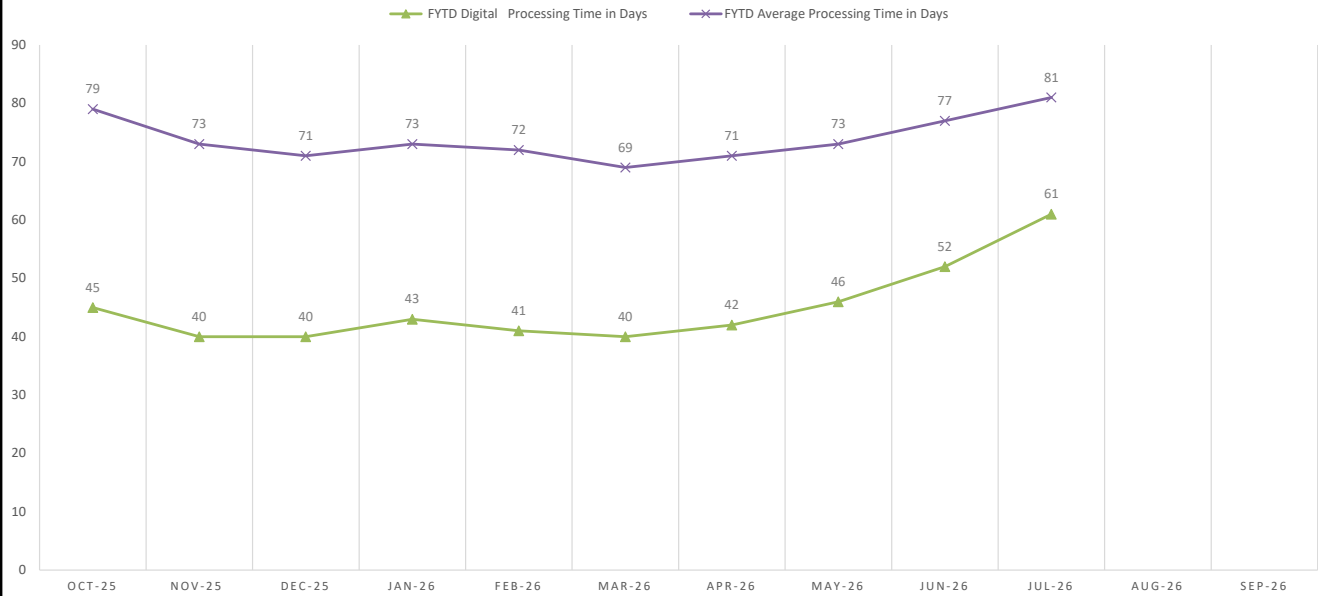

Retirement Services (RS) is working towards a fully digital retirement application process; RS is working with agencies and payroll offices to update legacy processes. During this period of transition, RS is still receiving many new retirement claims on paper.

- In July, RS Received 10,538 new retirement claims; of these 8,400 were digital and 2,138 were paper.

The processing of digital cases is faster. With systematic checks of data, annuitants experience fewer delays due to missing information or incomplete packages.

- In July, digital cases were processed in 98 days, and paper claims were processed in 156 days.
