Program Materials	<p><u>The 2014 Guide to Federal Benefits</u> - Provides summary information on the FSAFEDS, FEDVIP, and FEHB Programs and lists the participating plans. Summary information includes plans available in each state, rates, benefits, and quality indicators. See Benefits Administration Letter (BAL 13-402) for ordering instructions. You can find electronic versions of the Guide at www.opm.gov/healthcare-insurance/healthcare/plan-information/guides/ in early November.</p> <p>TIP: If you are unable to provide FEDVIP and FEHB brochures for the geographical area in which an employee resides, please provide them with plan telephone number(s) listed in the 2014 Guide to Federal Benefits. The employee can then contact the plan directly for a brochure.</p> <hr/> <p><u>2013 Federal Benefits Open Season FastFacts</u> – Both the <i>2013 Federal Benefits Open Season is Coming!</i> and <i>What to Consider During Open Season</i> provide snapshots of basic information on the upcoming Federal Benefits Open Season. If you don't receive FFS plan brochures by November 1, 2013, please contact your agency's headquarters.</p> <p>The ordering process for FFS health plan brochures is finished. If you did not order FFS health plan brochures, you can access these brochures at www.opm.gov/FEHBbrochures.</p> <p>Request health maintenance organization plan (HMO), consumer driven health plan (CDHP), and high deductible health plan (HDHP) brochures directly from health plan contacts listed in Attachment 4.
