Audience Comments / Questions and Answers

Q: Why do some preferred provider organizations (PPOs) cover IHS facilities and others do not? A: OPM does not determine who is in the FEHB providers' networks. That is between PPOs and IHS facilities.

Q: Are only employees paid directly through 638 funds eligible for FEHB And FEGLI?

A: No, any employee that works for a Tribe receiving 638 funds is eligible for FEHB and FEGLI.

An employee does not need to be paid directly with 638 funds to be eligible for these Programs.

Q: Are tribal contract schools eligible for FEHB and FEGLI?

A: Providing the contract school is carrying out programs under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act and directly receiving 638 funds, the contract school is eligible for FEHB and FEGLI.
