**Subject: Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance (FEGLI) Program: Revisions of FE-6, Claim for Death Benefits and FE-6 DEP, Statement of Claim-Option C Family Life Insurance**

**Why did OPM and the Office of Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance (OFEGLI) revise the forms FE-6 and FE-6DEP?**

OPM and OFEGLI revised the forms to:

- Provide beneficiaries more information on the two payment options for the life insurance proceeds
- Give beneficiaries a choice to elect to receive the life insurance proceeds by check or MetLife Total Control Account (TCA), an interest bearing account set up in the beneficiary's name, with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (MetLife).

**What are the revision dates?**

The revised forms are dated February 2011.

**How do we obtain the forms?**

**Can we use previous editions of the forms?**

No. You should discard all previous editions since new information has been added to the forms.
